Solid Waste Disposal Information

TRANSFER STATION

Address: 2455 Hemmert Ave
Phone: (208) 528-5550
Hours: Monday – Saturday 7:00am – 7:00 pm

Accepted Waste: The Transfer Station will accept all household garbage, bulky metal items, appliances, refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, furniture, mattresses, carpet, tires, automobile batteries (lead acid only), waste oil (5 gallons or less), paint (solidified only) and grass.

Fees: There is a \$10.00 fee for refrigerators, freezers and air conditioners. The fee for tire disposal is listed in the table below.

Out of County Waste Fees: 1) \$10.00 per refrigerator, freezer and air conditioner; 2) \$38.00/ton for household waste.

Notes: 1) Up to 5 gallons of waste oil is accepted per day; 2) **No salvaging allowed;** 3) **Please cover or tarp all loads.**

HATCH PIT

Accepted Waste: The Hatch Pit will only accept construction and demolition debris which includes wood products, lumber, road spoils, bricks, concrete, packing material, bulky metal items, tree stumps, branches, yard debris, weeds, soil, rocks gravel and asphalt.

Waste NOT Accepted: The Hatch Pit WILL NOT ACCEPT treated wood (i.e. railroad ties, fence posts), burn barrels, paper, agricultural waste (seeds, hay, straw, manure, animal carcass), household garbage, clothes, appliances, refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, electronics, fluorescent lights or fixtures, furniture, mattresses, carpet, tires, automobile batteries, waste oil, paint or empty paint cans, bug spray, herbicides, plastic or metal flammable fuel containers, black bags of anything, food of any kind including garden produce and grass.

Notes: 1) No salvaging allowed; 2) Please cover or tarp all loads.

TIRES

Tires may be disposed at the Transfer Station based on the fees shown below. Earth moving equipment tires still on rims will not be accepted.
