

**NOTICE OF ELECTIONS  
BONNEVILLE COUNTY, IDAHO**

As required by Section 34-602 of the Idaho Code, NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Bonneville County will be conducting the following elections listed below on Tuesday, August 28, 2018. The polls will be open from eight (8) a.m. to eight (8) p.m.

**Idaho School District No. 91, Bonneville County, Idaho – Special General Obligation Bond Election:**

**Question No. 1:**

Shall the Board of Trustees of School District No. 91, Bonneville County, State of Idaho (the "Board"), be authorized to issue general obligation school bonds of said District in the principal amount not to exceed \$86,200,000 for the purpose of financing the costs of (i) renovating, repairing, equipping and furnishing Skyline High School; (ii) constructing, furnishing and equipping a new Idaho Falls High School; and (iii) remodeling a portion of the existing Idaho Falls High School campus to develop a career and technical education center, together with all related furnishings and equipment necessary to operate said facilities, the final installment of such bonds to fall due not later than twenty years (20) years from the date of issuance thereof, all as provided in the Bond Election Resolution adopted by the Board on June 13, 2018?

The interest rate anticipated on the proposed bond issue under Question No. 1, based upon current market rates, is three and twenty-six hundredths percent (3.26%) per annum. The amount to be repaid over the life of the bonds, based on the anticipated interest rate, is \$108,075,596, consisting of \$86,200,000 in principal and \$31,915,405 of interest, totaling \$118,115,405, less \$10,039,809 in estimated bond levy equalization payments. The estimated average annual cost to the taxpayer on the proposed bond is a tax of \$157 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value based on current conditions and the data above. As of August 28, 2018, the total existing bonded indebtedness of the District, including interest accrued, is \$35,177,123.

**Question No. 2:**

Shall the Board of Trustees of School District No. 91, Bonneville County, State of Idaho (the "Board"), be authorized to issue general obligation school bonds of said District in the principal amount not to exceed \$13,300,000 for the purpose of financing the costs of acquisition, construction, furnishing and equipping of (i) in conjunction with the renovations to Skyline High School described in Question No. 1 above, a District-wide performing arts center; and (ii) in conjunction with the new Idaho Falls High School described in Question No. 1 above, a multipurpose space for physical education, athletics, performing arts, and large group meetings including in each case all relevant lighting, heating, ventilation and sanitation facilities and appliances necessary to maintain and operate the foregoing building and facilities, the final installment of such bonds to fall due not later than twenty years (20) years from the date of issuance thereof, provided, however, that the bonds and purposes described in this Question No. 2 shall be authorized only if the bonds and purposes in Question No. 1 are approved, all as provided in the Bond Election Resolution adopted by the Board on June 13, 2018?

The interest rate anticipated on the proposed bond issue under Question No. 2, based upon current market rates, is three and twenty-six hundredths percent (3.26%) per annum. The total amount to be repaid over the life of the bonds, based on the anticipated interest rate, is \$16,675,237 consisting of \$13,300,000 in principal and \$4,924,303 of interest, totaling \$18,224,303, less \$1,549,066 in estimated bond levy equalization payments. The estimated average annual cost to the taxpayer on the proposed bond is a tax of \$24 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value based on current conditions and the data above. As of August 28, 2018, the total existing bonded indebtedness of the District, including interest accrued, is \$35,177,123.

**Bonneville Joint School District No. 93, Bonneville County, Idaho – Supplemental Maintenance and Operations Levy Election:**

Shall the Board of Trustees of Joint School District No. 93, Bonneville and Bingham Counties, State of Idaho (the "District"), be authorized and empowered to levy a supplemental levy, as provided in Section 33-802(3), Idaho Code, in the amount of up to five million eight hundred thousand dollars (\$5,800,000) each year for two years, for the purpose of paying all lawful expenses of maintaining and operating the schools of the District for the fiscal years beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021, all as provided in the Resolution of the District's Board of Trustees adopted June 27, 2018?

Individual bond and levy questions will appear only on ballots of voters within their respective district boundaries. Electors must have resided in their respective districts at least thirty (30) days preceding the elections. Early Voting is being conducted in the Bonneville County Elections Office at 825 Shoup Ave, Idaho Falls, weekdays eight (8) a.m. to five (5) p.m. through August 24, 2018. The polls will be open from eight (8) a.m. to eight (8) p.m. on August 28, 2018. The precinct polling places in Bonneville County for these elections are as follows:
