

RESOLUTION No. 05-14

RESOLUTION TO TRANSFER DRUG COURT TREATMENT FUNDS TO MADISON COUNTY

AT A MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, BONNEVILLE COUNTY, IDAHO, ON THE 24 th DAY OF October, 2005, THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS UNANIMOUSLY ADOPTED, TO WIT:

WHEREAS, Madison County has assumed the FY 05 and 06 responsibility of acting as the financial administrator for all Drug Court treatment funds allocated by the Idaho Supreme Court and Idaho Department of Health and Welfare to the Seventh Judicial District.

WHEREAS, Bonneville County had previously provided financial administrator services for Drug Court treatment for fiscal years 03 and 04, and accrued a \$100,000.00 cash balance, and that of this balance, approximately \$50,000.00 was accrued for Bonneville County Drug Court treatment services, \$30,000.00 for Madison County (Upper Valley) Drug Court treatment services, and \$20,000.00 for Bingham County Drug Court treatment services.

WHEREAS, the financial administrator is required to pay for Drug Court treatment services rendered and then secure reimbursement from Health and Welfare, thus a 30 to 90 day cash reserve is required.

Bonneville County agrees to transfer the \$100,000.00 for Drug Court treatment to Madison County with the understanding that if the Drug Court treatment program is terminated in the future, or Madison County decides to no longer provide financial administrator services, and the treatment funds are not fully utilized by the Seventh Judicial District Drug Courts, that half of any remaining balance will be returned to Bonneville County Drug Court fund, and 20% returned to the Bingham County Drug Court fund.
