

**Title 67, Chapter 28 Sole Source Expenditures Resolution No. 09-03**

WHEREAS, The equipment which needs to be acquired is used for monitoring and electrical interventions in field situations where time is critical.

WHEREAS, the equipment which needs to be acquired is similar to or in the case of the LifePak 15 is the same as to equipment already in use: The City/County Ambulance service uses three generations of monitor/defibrillator equipment which is manufactured by Physio Control, (LifePak 10, LifePak 12, and LifePak 15). The controls, settings and internal software are familiar to emergency personnel and would not require extensive additional training. Introducing another vendor's monitor/defibrillator would require separate training and greatly increase the potential for confusion in life threatening situations. Acquiring dissimilar equipment would also require the City/County ambulance service to have a separate inventory of disposable equipment (EKG patches, cables, finger probes, etc). The City/County ambulance service would also need to have a separate maintenance agreement.

WHEREAS, Presently Physio Control is the only vendor which offers Carbon Monoxide (CO) monitoring.


WHEREAS, The City/County ambulance service did field trials and found no other vendor which compares to Physio Control.

THEREFORE BE IT Resolved that pursuant to Idaho Code 67, Chapter 28, Bonneville County to purchase monitor/defibrillator from Physico Control, and order Notice to be published for at least 14 calendar days prior to the award of the contract.



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
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
