RESOLUTION NO.: 10-06

A Resolution by the Bonneville County Board of Commissioners to Declare its Intention to Vacate County a Road Right-of-Way in Road Map Area 2 of Bonneville County

WHEREAS, the Bonneville County Public Works Department has identified public right-of-way no longer in the public interest that should be considered for abandonment and vacation; and

WHEREAS, the abandonment and vacation of any road or right-of-way will not eliminate access to public lands or water; and

WHEREAS, the abandonment and vacation of any road or right-of-way will not leave any real property without access to an established public right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, in order to consider roads and rights-of-way in a geographical proximity the County has been divided into several areas that will be heard separately; and

WHEREAS, Road Map Area 2 is bounded on the north by the north county line, on the east by 115th East, on the south by Highway 26 from its intersection with 115th East to its intersection with 33rd North and 33rd North from its intersection with Highway 26 to its intersection with the east bank of the Snake River and on the west by the east bank of the Snake River;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Bonneville County Board of Commissioners that, in accordance with Section 40-203, Idaho Code, it hereby declares its intention to abandon and vacate the following described County right-of-way in Road Map Area 2:

Right-of-Way No. 64: Beginning on the east right-of-way of 95th East Road at a point approximately 25 feet East of the West Quarter Corner of Section 11 , T3N, R39E, of the Boise Meridian, thence East approximately 650 feet to a point on the northwesterly right-of-way line of Highway 26.
