RESOLUTION NO.: 12-01

A RESOLUTION REGARDING THE REFUNDING OF PROPERTY TAXES, CONDITIONS THEREFORE PROVIDING FOR RECISSION AND REPEAL OF ALL RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Bonneville County, Idaho, is charged with the collection of property taxes, and

WHEREAS, from time to time taxpayers may be owing delinquent taxes, and

WHEREAS, the Treasures is charged with the collection of taxes for various taxing districts in the county;

NOW THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Bonneville County Commission that the following policy shall be and here is adopted as the official policy of Bonneville County, Idaho as follows:

Section 1. In cases where refunds for property taxes are to be issued, the excess funds should first be applied to pay any delinquent taxes of said taxpayer. If, after paying the delinquent taxes there are funds remaining, these funds may be refunded to the payee or the property owner as the case may be. The payee may authorize the refund to be sent to another party only when a notarized statement of request for the same is provided to the Treasurer.

Section 2. An exception to the above policy may be taken if the payee, from whom the overpayment originated, is no longer the current owner of the property. In addition, if taxes are owing, but the account is current, refunds may be issued to the appropriate party.

Repeal of Resolutions and Conflicts


That all resolutions heretofore adopted which are in conflict herewith, are hereby rescinded and appealed.


Effective Date:

Passed by the Commission this 2nd day of February 2012.


