

RESOLUTION NO. 14-02

A Resolution by the Bonneville County Board of Commissioners Authorizing the Public Works Department to Apply to the BLM for Rights-of-Way

---

WHEREAS, the Bonneville County Public Works Department has identified public roads maintained by Bonneville County which are located on federal land managed by the Bureau of Land Management; and

WHEREAS, said road rights-of-way are located in the North Half of Section 6, Township 3 North, Range 41 East, of the Boise Meridian and are commonly referred to as the 143<sup>rd</sup> North (Byington Access Road) and Byington Drive; and

WHEREAS, the federal government has only recognized a RS 2477 right-of-way for 143<sup>rd</sup> North but not for Byington Drive; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department requires a right-of-way to access Byington Drive for road maintenance; and

WHEREAS, a Right-of-Way Grant from the Bureau of Land Management will formalize the right-of-way for 143<sup>rd</sup> North and provide access to Byington Drive;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Bonneville County Board of Commissioners that the Bonneville County Public Works Department is hereby authorized to make application to the Bureau of Land Management for the 143<sup>rd</sup> North and Byington Drive rights-of-way.


