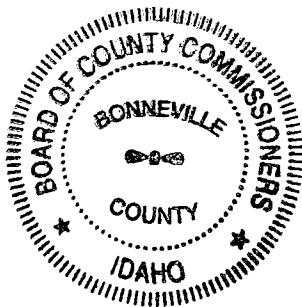
**RESOLUTION NO. 15-02 OF BONNEVILLE COUNTY, IDAHO,

Specifically, the sheriff's office is looking to grant outdated TASER equipment to smaller agencies that would be able to get some use from the equipment


Background: TASER International has discontinued the support of their X26 models and the cartridges will be available for other models. In foresight of this change, the Sheriff's Office implemented a tiered upgrade to the manufacturer supported X2 model. Rather than destroying/disposing still functional equipment, smaller law enforcement agencies could reap short-term safety benefits.



We are requesting a resolution by the County Commissioners (31-808, 9), giving the Sheriff's Office authority to grant law enforcement equipment no longer used by BCSO to other law enforcement agencies. We are also requesting permission to destroy any non-functioning equipment.
