RESOLUTION OF INTENTION

BONNEVILLE COUNTY LIGHTING DISTRICTS

Nos. 26 through 32

BONNEVILLE COUNTY, IDAHO

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BONNEVILLE COUNTY, IDAHO, as follows:

WHEREAS, the owners of properties in various subdivisions of the County have requested the County Commissioners to form lighting districts applicable to each such area and subdivision to provide security lighting for the safety, welfare, and benefit of the residents of the respective areas;

WHEREAS, Bonneville County (the "County"), through the County Commissioners, has legal authority under the Idaho statutes to impose and collect fees for services provided by the County which would otherwise be funded by ad valorem tax revenues; and

WHEREAS, fees collected pursuant to the authority of the Idaho statutes should be reasonably related to but should not exceed the actual cost of the service being rendered; and

WHEREAS, the owners of the respective areas constitute a majority of the ownership within each of the respective areas and have requested, respectively, the County Commission to set up lighting districts for each of said areas to which said owners are associated, to collect fees to defray the charges of furnishing electrical energy and power for the operation of a security lighting system; and

WHEREAS, the owners of such areas, as developers, have or will have installed the security lighting systems pursuant to the specifications of the County engineering department; and

WHEREAS, the fees to be charged in the lighting districts will be designed to pay the operation and maintenance cost to Utah Power and Light under schedules adopted by the Idaho Public Utilities Commission to provide security lighting.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that it is the intention of the Bonneville County Commissioners to establish a Bonneville County Lighting District for each of the subdivisions and areas which have requested such security lighting and to establish such lighting districts to collect fees to pay the operation and maintenance costs of Utah Power and Light under schedules adopted by the Idaho Public Utilities Commission for the furnishing of energy and power to operate a security lighting system. The fees and charges collected will be for the operation and maintenance on a

continuing basis and will be imposed and collected for services provided by the County which would otherwise be funded by ad valorem tax revenues. The intent is to collect fees pursuant to the authority of the Idaho statutes which shall be reasonably related to but will not exceed the actual cost of the service being rendered;

FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is the intention of the Bonneville County Commissioners to establish a lighting district for each of said subdivisions, hereinafter designated.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners shall hold a hearing upon the notice of intention to create the following lighting districts in the subdivisions as hereinafter designated.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that notice be given to all residents and owners within each of the designated subdivisions, hereinafter named, as such names appear on the assessment roll in the County Assessor's Office for properties within each of said subdivisions and within the boundaries of each of the proposed lighting districts; that such hearing shall be held on the intention to create the lighting districts; and that such notice as appears on Exhibit A, attached hereto and made a part hereof, shall be mailed by the clerk to all residents and owners appearing upon such assessment roll for each of said subdivisions and lighting districts, and shall be published in two publications of the official newspaper of the County, with the first publication being not less than fifteen (15) days prior to the date set for such hearing.

The subdivisions for which it is the intention to establish lighting districts and for which the Board of County Commissioners of Bonneville County shall hold a hearing upon the Notice of Intention to Create Lighting Districts and for which notice shall be given to the residents and owners within such subdivisions and proposed lighting districts are designated as follows:

26. Bonneville County Lighting District No. 26 (Green Oak Meadow, Division No. 1)

Lots 1 through 5, Block 1; Lots 1 through 4, Block 2; Lots 1 through 3, Block 3; Lots 1 through 9, Block 4, Green Oak Meadow, Division No. 1, Bonneville County, Idaho.

The street addresses are from Teeples Drive 432 North to 507 North; Garnet Street from 3238 East to 3290 East; Kit Lane from 3207 East to 3273 East.

27. Bonneville County Lighting District No. 27 (Centennial Ranch, Division No. 6)

Lots 9 through 21, Block 4; Lots 20 through 30, Block 6, Centennial Ranch, Division No. 6, Bonneville County, Idaho.

The street addresses are Aschli Lane from 4103 East to 43991 East; Wheatfield Lane from 927 South to 930 South.

28. Bonneville County Lighting District No. 28 (Cornerstone Community, Division No. 1)

Lots 1 through 29, Block 1; Lots 1 through 21, Block 2, Lots 1 through 5, Block 3; Lots 4 through 7, Block 4, Lots 5 through 15, Block 5, Lots 1 through 16, Block 8; Lots 1 through 16, Block 9; Lots 1 through 18, Block 10; Lot 1, Block 11; Lots 1 through 12, Block 12; Lot 1, Block 12, Cornerstone Community, Division No. 1, Bonneville County, Idaho.

The street addresses are Pearce Drive from 3518 East to 3746 East; Cornerstone Drive from 1080 North to 1322 North; Moonstone Drive from 1058 North to 1378 North; Goldstone Drive from 3606 East to 3704 East; Capstone Drive from 3604 East to 3706 East; Silverstone Drive from 3605 East to 3702 East; Stevens Drive from 1125 North to 1364 North.

29. Bonneville County Lighting District No. 29 (Warm Springs Meadow, Division No. 1)

Lots 1 through 9, Block 1; Lots 1 through 9, Block 2; Warm Springs Meadow, Division No. 1, Bonneville County, Idaho.

The street addresses are Heath Lane from 156 South to 438 South; Heath Circle from 3802 East to 3836 East.

30. Bonneville County Lighting District No. 30 (Fall Creek Subdivision, Division No. 2)

Lots 16 through 29, Block 1; Lots 11 through 20, Block 2; Fall Creek Subdivision, Division No. 2, Bonneville County, Idaho.

The street addresses are Deer Creek from 3766 East to 3958 East.

31. Bonneville County Lighting District No. 31 (Miller Country Estates, Division No. 3)

Lots 12 through 26, Block 1; Lots 17 through 18, Block 2; Miller Country Estates Division No. 3, Bonneville County, Idaho.

The street addresses are 26th East from 9949 North to 10082 North; 27th East from 9963 North to 10078 North; 100th North from 2633 East to 2659 East.

32. Bonneville County Lighting District No. 32 (Lincoln Park Subdivision, Division No. 5, First Amended plat of:)


Lots 3 through 10, Block 5; Lots 4 through 17, Block 6; Lincoln Park
Subdivision, Division No. 5, Bonneville County, Idaho.

The street addresses are Greenwillow Lane from 3737 East to 3836 East.


FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners do hereby set Wednesday, the 13th day of October, 1999, at 1:30 p.m. as the time and place at which time a protest hearing shall be held and any and all protests against said proposed lighting districts to be formed shall be heard. That all such protests shall be in writing and filed with the Office of the County Commissioners in the County Courthouse, Bonneville County, Idaho, on or before 1:30 p.m. on the 13th day of October, 1999.

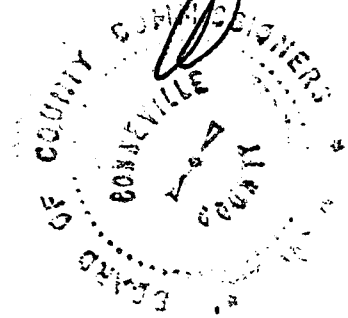
